

Tanzania win their second game against Kenya at Lugogo ground in Kampala.

The determined Tanzanian team played their hearts out today at Lugogo ground in Kampala against Kenya. After winning the toss Tanzania decided to bat first. Once again the Tanzanian in form skipper Monica Pascal played her inning scoring 54 runs off 77 bowls for her team before being caught by Lucy of Kenya in the 16th over.
